What would you do if you could go volunteering?

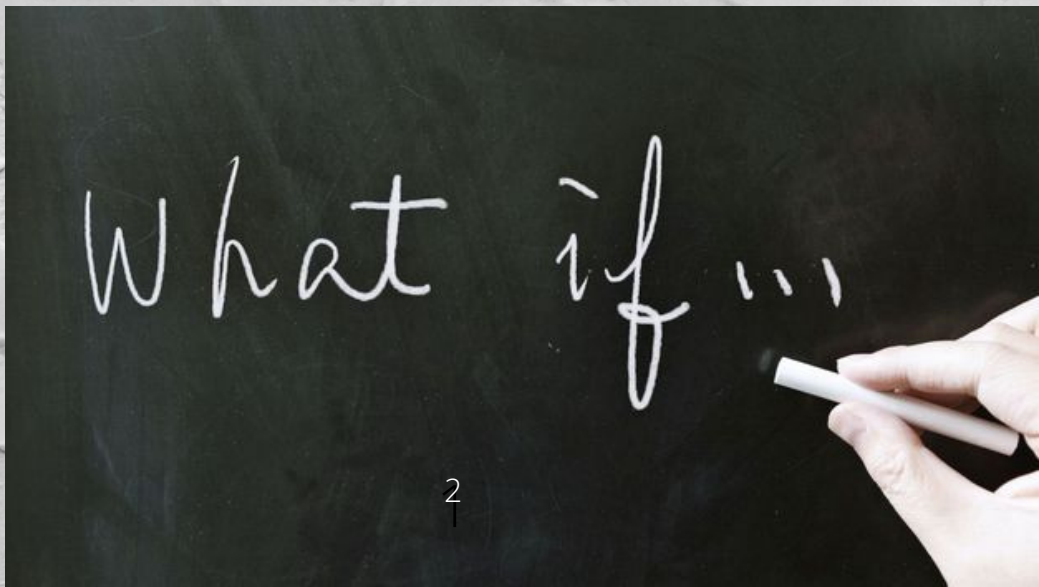

3. BENEFIT FROM YOUR FRIENDS

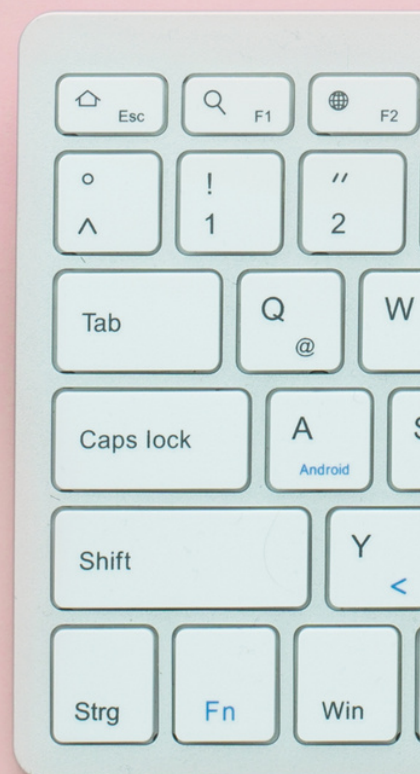
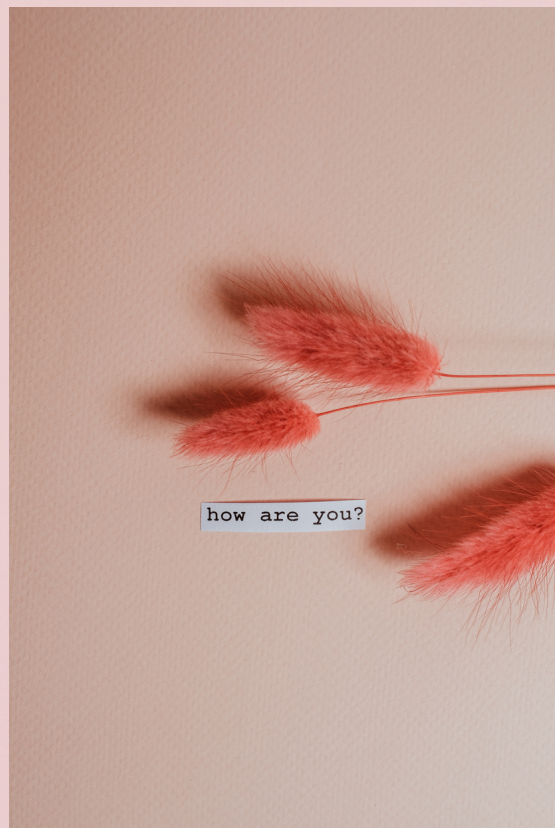

As a child it was František Konvička from Zbrojovka Brno.

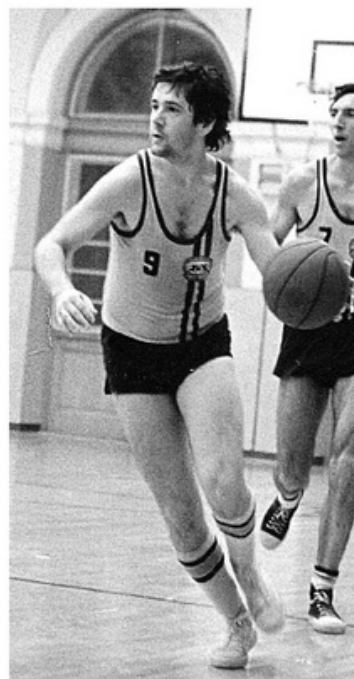
Now I don't prefer any player or team.

Basketball is a beautiful team sport. I try to make the kids enjoy it, built a team and a good bunch.



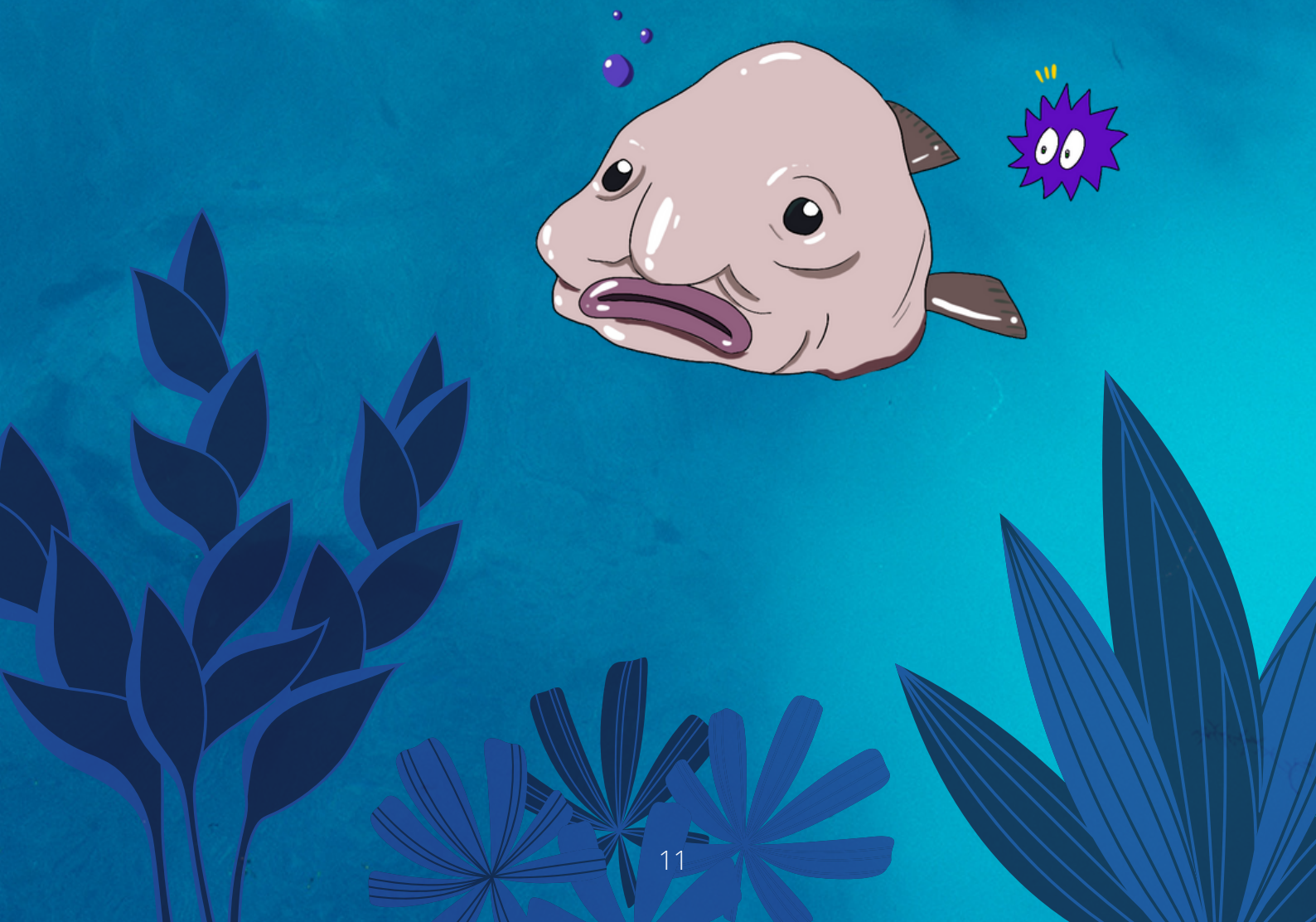
UNUSUAL ANIMALS

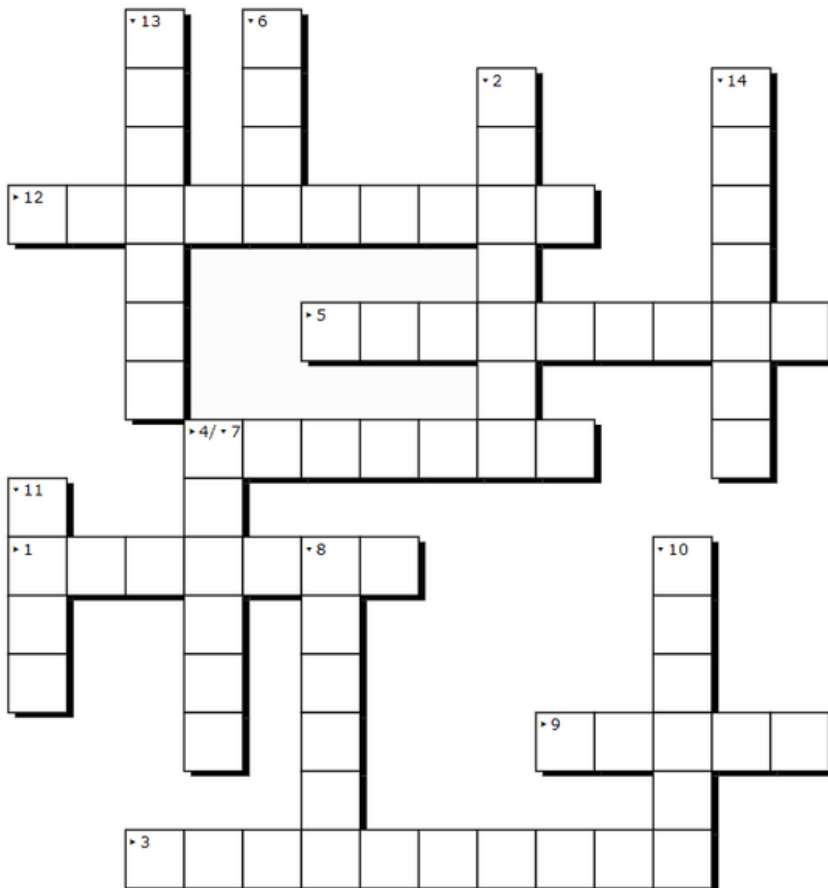

Ask Questions - Asking the teacher questions might not seem important to the students, but to the teachers, it is. From just one simple question they can figure out who are paying attention in the class

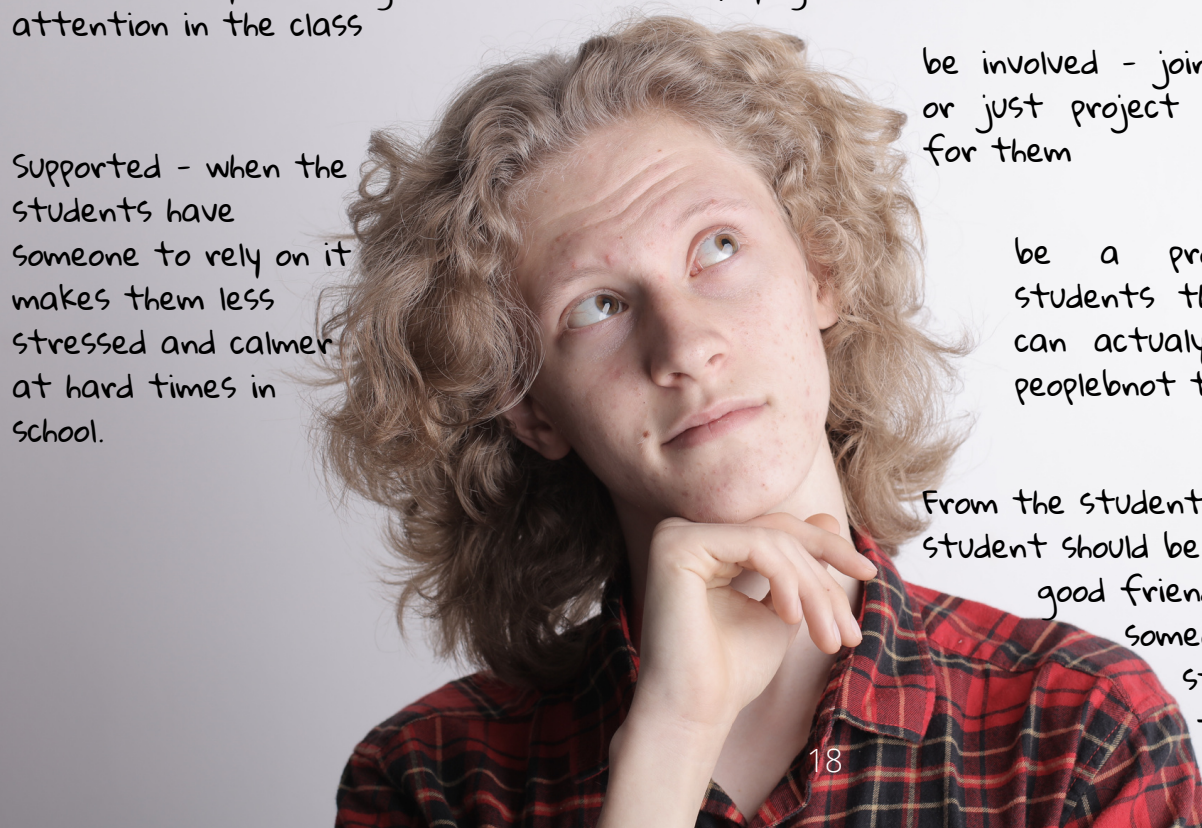
be hard working - This involves studying for the tests or doing homework.

Speech

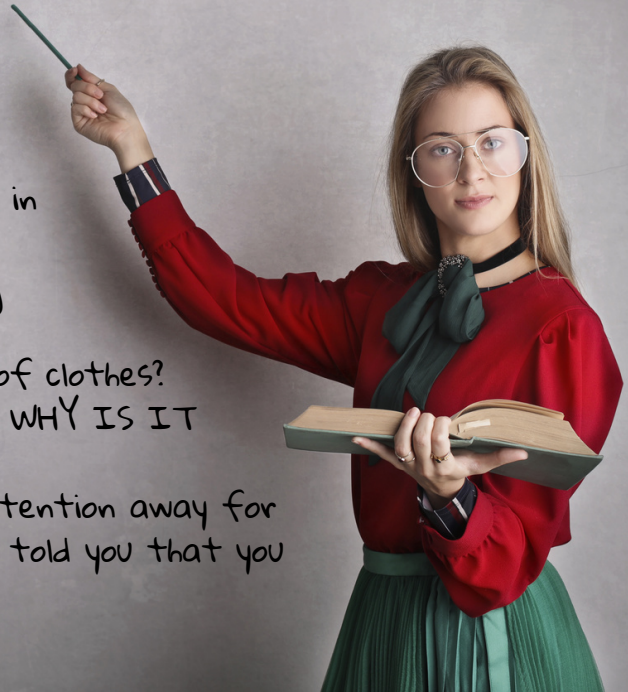
They would need to have not fast but also not slow speech, if they would talk slow and wouldn't add some waves to their sentences, students would get bored quickly, or even fall a sleep.

Style is also important, some catchy, or bright colours of clothes can drive students attetion away, for example Let's put yourself in this position:

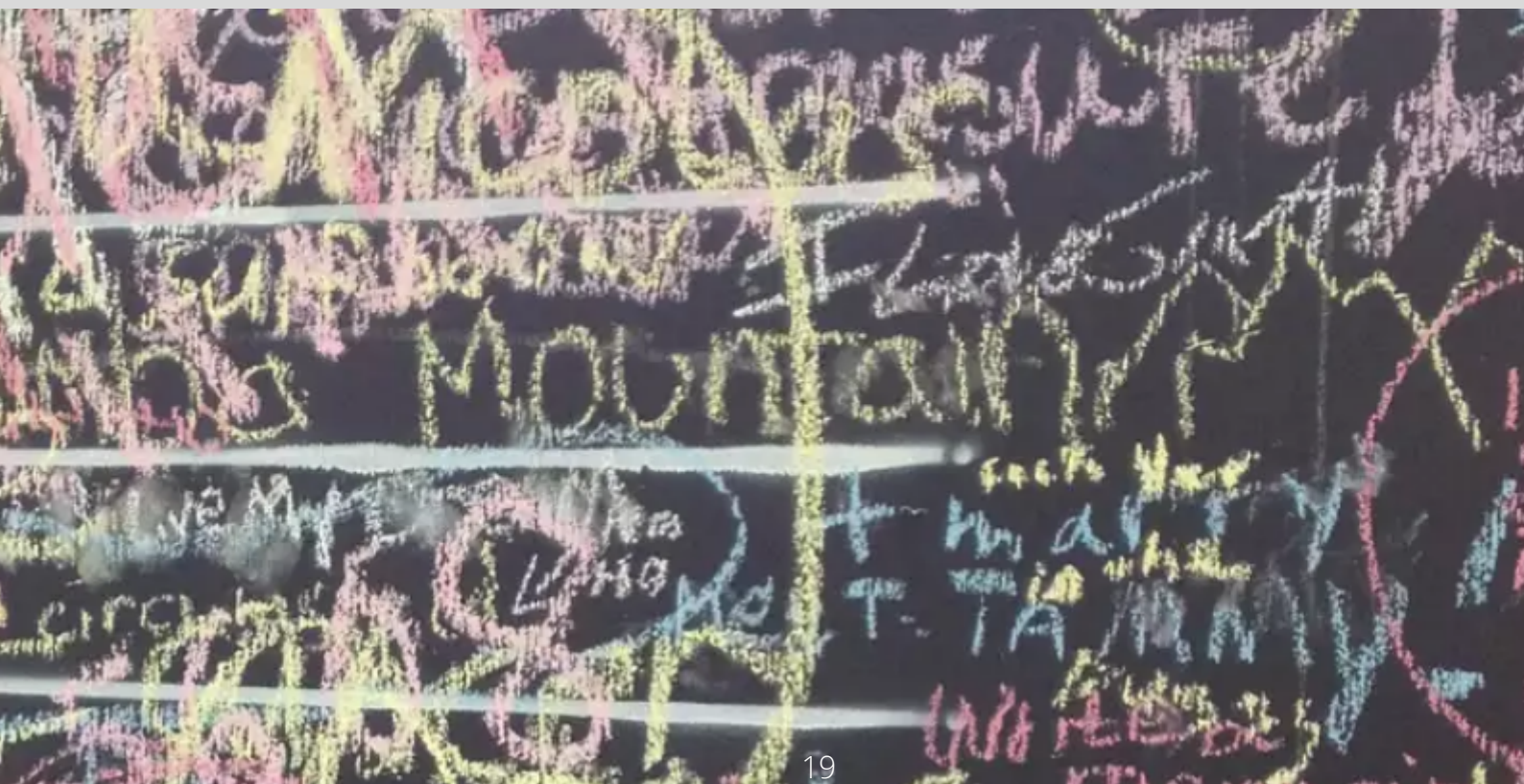

Handwriting might seem unimportant, but it is not. If teachers write too messy or their handwriting is illegible, students wouldn't be able to take good notes which will effect their success.

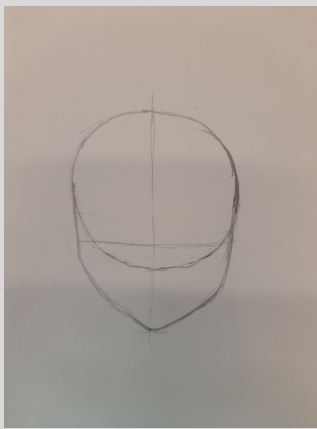


How to draw an anime character

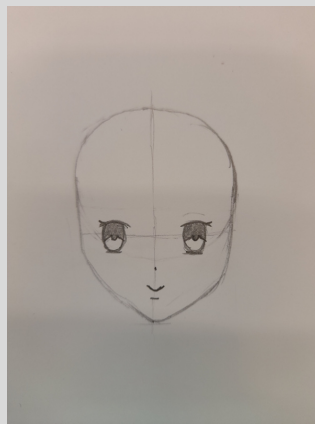
easy drawing - anime head

1. let's draw a circle. Then we finish the rest of the head according to the picture.



2. we draw fine lines in the middle and in one third of the head. Draw the eyes so that the horizontal line passes through half of the eyes. Then we finish the mouth and nose according to the picture.



3. Draw a strand with two tips in the middle of the head and go on each side adding one strand at a time that contains one tip. finally, we can add longer strands.



4. we will draw one braid on each side and a larger ponytail will hang from each braid.



5. DETAILS: As details we can add a couple of free-standing hair or some staples and rubber bands.
