# Queen Elizabeth

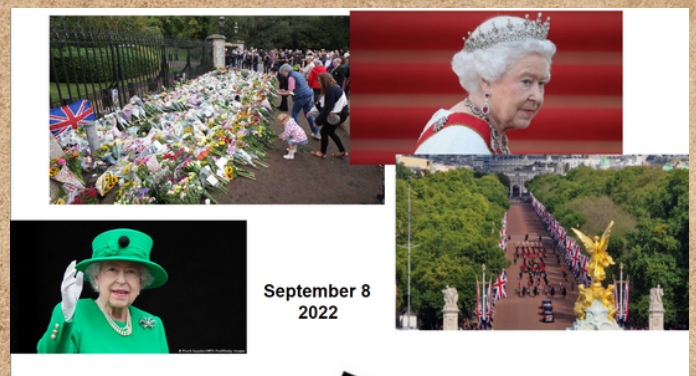
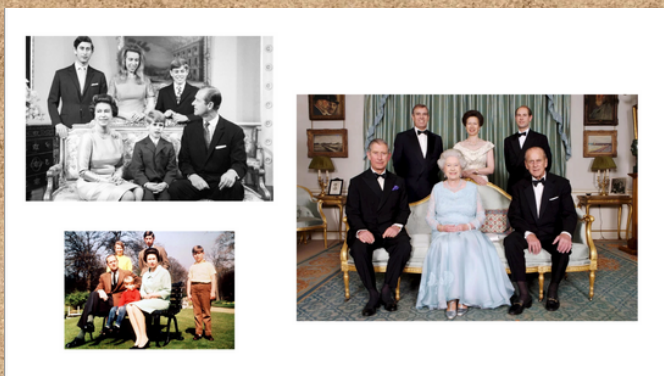

In the online report, we follow the trial of ex-prime minister Andrej Babiš and manager Jana Nagyová (Mayerová), who are accused in the case surrounding the Hornbill's Nest project.

The trial of the defendants Andrej Babiš and manager Jana Mayerová (Nagyová) continues for the eighth day at the Municipal Court in Prague.



However, the meeting was partly without their participation. Andrej Babiš did not come to the court in the morning at all, Jana Nagyová (Mayerová) then apologized for the afternoon.

Marketing and graphics specialist Jakub Antoš, who in 2013 presented Andrej Babiš with a proposal for an advertisement for Cap's nest, testified at the court in the morning.





For example, when Judge Šott presented him with an e-mail to read, in which Antoš's colleague writes in connection with the Sparrow's Nest about a "big boss" who approves the work, the witness answered clearly: "It was Mr. Babiš." Jiří Javůrek, the architect of Čapí's nest, also testified in a similar vein.

Another witness - construction supervisor from Cap's nest Jan Bareš - described the creation of the project to the court. According to him, nobody wanted a farm in Agrofert because it was a very loss-making enterprise.

The summoned financial director of Agrofert, Petra Procházková, sent an excuse for illness. The judge said he would summon her to the October hearing.



# WASTE COLLECTING BOATS

Garbage is a threat to marine life. Animals often mistake the plastic in the ocean for food. They can also get stuck in bigger pieces of plastic or other garbage. "Why should I care for the animals?" you say. The fish with plastic inside it eventually makes its way up in the food chain and gets eaten by humans. Companies like The Ocean Cleanup have dedicated themselves to solving this problem. They have created a boat named The Interceptor that cleans up the trash for the oceans. It



collects larger pieces of plastic before they degrade into micro plastics. This boat is also solar powered and completely automated. It cleans up about 100,000 kilograms of trash PER DAY. 2 of these boats exist. 1 is in Indonesia and 1 in Malaysia and they hope to have 2 more in the future. They plan to use The Interceptors to target rivers that contribute more than 80% of the plastic. Donations can be sent to The Ocean Cleanup Pacific Foundation.

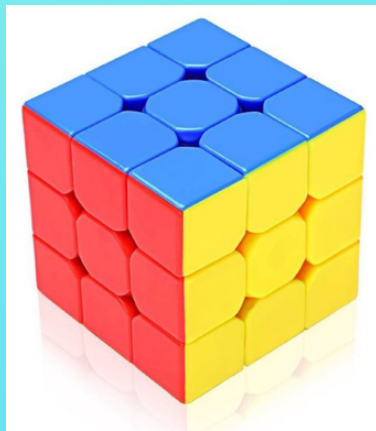


# Cubes

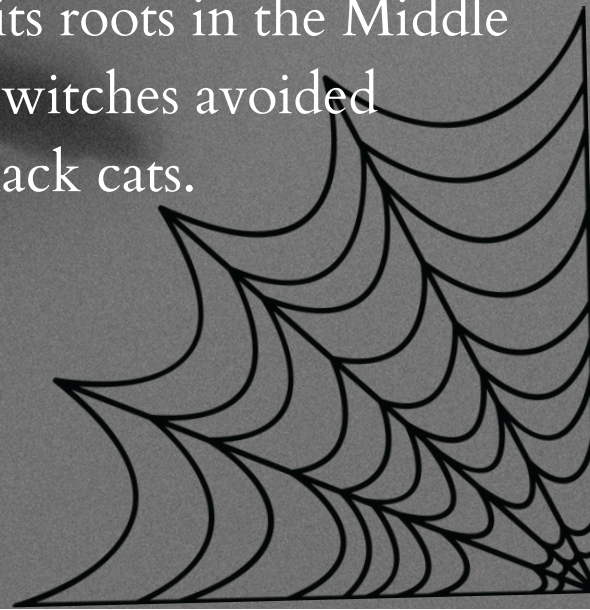
## *Ancient origins of Halloween*








# *History of Trick-or-Treating*
