


What do astronauts eat?

How do they go to the toilet?


Lukáš: They have special toilet they can't flush the toilet they have special tube that goes somewhere they have to strap themselves so they won't fly away from the toilet

Nail clipping must be done over a special air duct.



The book had special ways of setting Forrest into some situations. And it was mostly funny watching him randomly match some geniuses while proclaiming that he is an idiot.



Energy drinks



The Last of Us

The last of us is an American post-apocalyptic drama television series created by Craig Mazin and Neil Druckmann for HBO. It was based on a video game released in 2013, developed by Naughty Dog. The series is set in 2023, twenty years into a pandemic caused by a mass fungal infection, which causes its hosts to transform into zombie-like creatures and destroys society. The series follows Joel, a smuggler tasked with escorting the immune teenager Ellie across a post-apocalyptic United States.

A hardened survivor, tormented by past trauma and failure, who must trek across a pandemic-ravaged America, all the while protecting a girl who represents the last hope of humanity.

Ellie Williams

A fourteen year old orphan who has never known anything but a ravaged planet, struggles to balance her instinct for anger and defiance with her need for connection and belonging... as well as the newfound reality that she may be the key to saving the world.









A serial called "the middle" is a family-friendly comedy about a family that lives in a small city named Orson in America. The family has 5 people in it. Firstly, there is a mum Frankie, then dad Mike and three children called Axl, Sue and Brick. The family lives an ordinary life as us, with nice experiences and enjoyments, but also with arguments and problems. They often fight, but still love each other as most families do. They solve all of the troubles together. They don't have much money and often face financial problems. However, Mike and Frankie are trying their best for the kids. Axl is an athlete and the oldest child. He excuses himself, is messy and bullies his younger sister, yet he's genuinely funny. Sue is the middle child. She is always happy, cheerful, creative, positive and shows a lot of emotions. She helps her family. On the other hand, she is awkward and a muff. Brick, the youngest child, is most of the time disregarding and has no friends, because he is in his own way "weird" and different. He loves reading books, mostly including adventures. After all, he found himself a girlfriend and lives a happy life, together with her. The series has 9 seasons - each season is one year of their life. I like this serial, because it's funny a lot and in some ways reminds me of my own family.

Women= Lace tops but fishnet stockings, calflength black leggings and knee-high leather boots.



HALA FRUIT

Hala fruit, also called Pandanus tectorius, comes from Malaysia. It grows on beaches by the sea. The fruit resembles pineapple or mango and it has 38–200 keys or carpels. The Color of the fruit can be yellow, orange, or red. When ripe, they turn vivid orange, yellow, or red.

Hala fruit is a rare, tropical species belonging to the Pandanaceae family. Intake of hala fruit, which is high in dietary fibre, may promote health. eating them has helped their circulation and heart health.


