



Art in the 15th century is of the renaissance style and consists of paintings of people and landscapes. One of the most famous painters from that time is Leonardo da Vinci with his well known paintings, for example The Vitruvian man, The Lady with an ermine, The last supper, and one of them being the Mona Lisa which I'm going to write about.





The painting features a younger lady in her 20's, she is looking at us and smiling slightly, her smile feels a little provoking. Her hair reaches her shoulders and is slightly wavy with a dark brown colour. The veil on her head is easy to miss as it blends in with her hair. Her dress is a dark, olive green colour. Her right hand is placed on her left one softly, her left hand is placed on the backrest of the chair she is sitting on. We can only see her from her waist up. The background is that of a beautiful forest scenery. Slightly behind her is a lake big enough to fit in most of the background. Right behind her is a more dry, rocky area.

The girl with the Pearl earring is another famous painting, this time from Jan Vermeer. The painting shows another young lady looking over her shoulder at us. She has a blue and yellow cloth wrapped around her head. The blue part of the cloth starts a little above her eyebrows, the yellow part is from the middle of the top of her head and hangs down to her shoulders. She is looking back at us, her eyes feel as if she's wondering something. The Pearl that this painting is named after glimmers in the dark setting of the painting. Her lips are a bright red colour and are slightly opened. Her clothes are a dark orange colour with a white neck line. The painting ends even before we see her waist. The background is fully black making the girl stand out.

The Story:


HISTORY OF THE GAME



IF THE PLAYER IS INJURED HE\SHE MUST LEAVE THE FIELD AND SOMEONE ELSE WILL TAKE THEIR PLACE. IF YOU WANT TO WIN A GAME, YOU HAVE TO HAVE A GOOD DEFENCE

Why is Český Krumlov so special?

Český Krumlov Region is among the most attractive regions in the Czech Republic. If you want to have good prices, and to be in the heart of the continent for exploring Europe, the Czech Republic is the best for you. MUFFINS

FOR 12 SERVINGS



INGREDIENTS:

100g granulated crystal sugar

2 eggs

5 spoons of milk

125g of butter

1 piece of chopped chocolate

250g plain flour

1 teaspoon of baking powder

PREPARATION:

1st step

Preheat the over to 180°C.

2nd step

Beat the softened butter, sugar and eggs until the sugar dissolves, add the flour and baking powder then mix it all together.

3rd step

Add milk, cut chocolate into small pieces and mix everything again.

4th step

Fill the muffin tin with the mixture and bake.

5th step

Leave the baked chocolate muffins to cool then you can serve them.







HOW TO MAKE A MINI DE SURVIVAL KIT
